Learn how to paint with purpose and energy; to create paintings that have mood, simple shapes, and strong values. Ron will show participants how to use deft brushstrokes that result in loose, transparent paintings. He believes that watercolor is simply the best medium to capture light, shadow and reflective surfaces. Each day of the workshop will consist of a demonstration, painting by participants, and individual assistance.
