Stan Fellows, accomplished illustrator and watercolor artist based in Longmont, Colorado, will teach watercolor journaling October 10-12, 2019 at the Ames Center in Burnsville. His playful approach and easy-to-remember tips and tools will help you paint in a more relaxed way. "Isn't it appealing to know that you can paint for ten minutes and complete something? And guess what? It doesn't feel like work—it feels fun," he says. The structure is relaxed: Stan does a ten minute demo; then participants try it.
