This question of acceptance or rejection can be stressful, but juried shows are an opportunity to think about your work as you select pieces to enter. They also present an opportunity to develop a "punch list" of items for improving your body of work and to deal with differing opinions about your work. Thus, juried shows are important and useful for artists, even when your work is not selected.




Please note that due to COVID-19 restrictions no refreshments will be served. Thanks to everyone who entered the show!

SHARING YOUR ART

The Minnesota Watercolor Society has two excellent options for sharing your art. The Fall Members Exhibit is a great way to learn how to prepare and frame your art to enter a competitive show. Painting to a theme is also important. Seeing your work alongside your peers is a



constructive experience, and the anticipation of an award or sale is exciting.

The juried entry Spring Show adds the acclaim of being accepted into the show by the juror. The opening receptions at both shows offer the opportunity to invite family and friends to see your work and the quality of the overall exhibit. I strongly recommend that all of you take these opportunities whenever you feel ready.

Another way to share is by having a solo or group show at a coffee shop, salon, place of worship or gallery. This non-competitive format show gives the artist a chance to share a wide variety of their work. In August the group of artists that I am part of had a gallery show in Robbinsdale. Everyone in the group put what they learned from their Fall and Spring show experiences to good use. We promoted the show through social media and the gallery distributed printed materials in the community. The local community cable group also promoted the show. It was an exciting and positive experience for all of us.

Dan helps take the mystery out of painting in his workshops. Of course, it's still challenging—which is part of the fun—but the visual language is something that he believes we all can learn.

In his workshops, he teaches shortcuts that save years of frustration and help you loosen up and enjoy fluid washes, expressive brushwork, and bold color.

Each morning and afternoon, he begins with a quick demonstration to illustrate the day's lesson, leaving a large majority of the time for students to work.

Many helpful drawing and painting tips will be covered as they present themselves during the workshop. Students will be amazed at how fast they can grow when they stop trying to paint "things" and instead focus their energy on communicating in the visual language of painting.
