Dan Mondloch will be demonstrating plein air painting so plan accordingly. Meeting demo will move to a nearby barn if weather is bad. We will be live only, and will not be on Zoom or recorded, due to WiFi limitations on site.

Wine is available for purchase. You are invited to bring a picnic supper to enjoy in the outdoors.

Painting outdoors is exhilarating because

you get to stretch your legs, enjoy fresh air, and immerse yourself in inspirational subjects. While emotion runs high when painting outside, sometimes the amount of material to paint from can be overwhelming. In this demo you will learn how to select a subject and simplify it utilizing the strength of large value shapes. Then, it's easier to loosen up and be confident using fluid washes and expressive brushwork.

Dan is an award winning third generation painter. His first interest in painting was in the 9th grade; while driving with his dad he mentioned he'd like to try painting. The next morning he woke to the kitchen table covered with everything he could ever possibly need to paint a picture! He's been featured in Plein Air Magazine and Southwest Art Magazine. Recent honors include the Jean Stern Legacy Award at Laguna Invitational and Best of Show at Grand Marais Plein Air. He lives in Cold



Spring, MN with his wife Mallory, sons Jack(7) and Drew(4), daughter Emma(2), and plein air painting canine bud - Ruby.

The MNWS Fall Exhibition is a non-juried show open to all active members who have paid dues through May 31, 2024. The first 65 paid entries will be accepted. Each member is allowed one entry. The \$30 fee is non-refundable and helps support the Minnesota Watercolor Society.

Registration will only be available online and we need a high quality jpeg file of your painting between 400 KB and 12 MB.

Paintings may be offered for sale or shown as NFS – not for sale. If your painting is NFS we will need a value of it for insurance purposes. The Ames Center will exclusively handle all transactions and collect a 25% commission. Artists must complete a W-9 form prior to receiving payment for art work.

All entries must follow MNWS Exhibition Rules which are posted on the MNWS website. Artists are strongly encouraged to completely read and understand rules before registering to avoid having a painting disqualified at drop-off.


